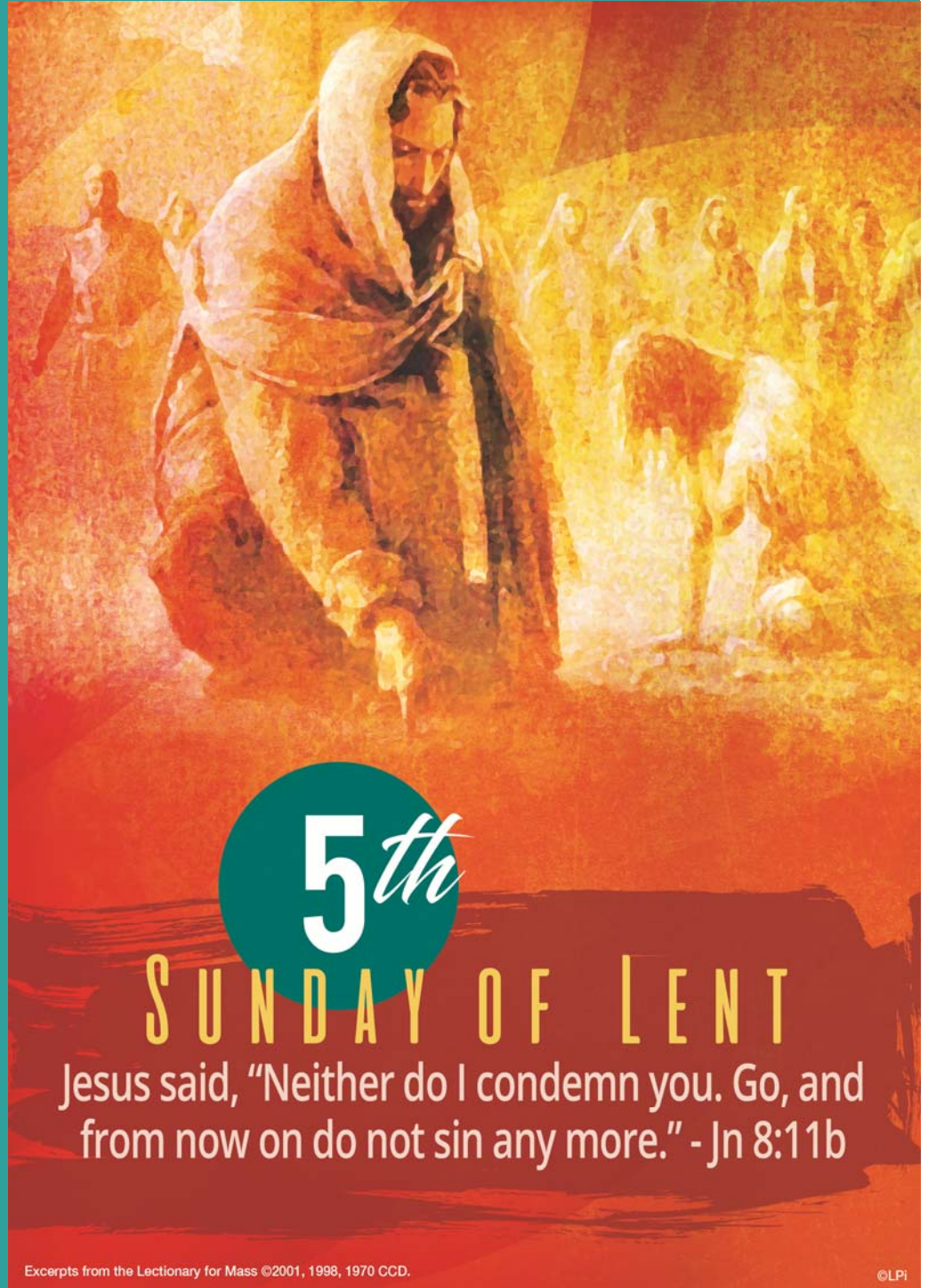

**EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP**

**April 7, 2019  
5th Sunday of Lent**

Some celebrities do a lot to help out various causes that are meaningful to them. Sometimes they give of their time, talent, or treasure, while other times they create giving opportunities for the rest of us to be generous. The celebrity then does much to highlight the cause, and the hope is that enough people will give to make a difference.

I never judge another's motive when they choose to give to or support a cause. However, I hear many times a criticism levied against seemingly rich people who start a fundraiser and ask the rest of us to give: "Since they have so much money, they could simply give all the money needed themselves!" This exclamation often comes with disdain and a tone of superiority. This sentiment also comes frequently from those who have chosen to give little to nothing to the cause themselves.

Stewardship begins with the person in the mirror. You and I are accountable to each other, but at the end of the day, the only one who knows the true level of our generosity is God. As this Lent draws to a close, it is time to take a good long look in the mirror. You probably aren't famous, so there probably won't be a crowd of people to question the level of your sacrifice, devotion, and generosity this Lent. Of course, God knows and so does that person looking back at you in the mirror.

**CHALLENGE OF THE CROSS**

Then Jesus said to all,  
“If anyone wishes to come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me. Luke 9:23-25

During Lent we are challenged to “...take up our Cross daily and follow...” Jesus!

During Lent we are invited and challenged to take any paper Cross. On the backside of each paper Cross is a challenge to provide a gift. The material gifts will be sorted in our Courtyard on Holy Saturday morning by our RCIA/Children and their Families, and then delivered to MARY’S MERCY CENTER and to VERONICA’S HOME OF MERCY in nearby San Bernardino.

Your challenge, your gift will benefit a homeless person or family, an expectant mother, an unborn child, a new mother or infant child. Your challenge, your gift can be as simple as a prayer or a toothbrush, or as challenging as a Rosary, a Mass, a pillow, or a blanket.

Yes, prayers are a challenge! Providing for others in a ‘material’ way doesn’t always answer every need!

Algunas celebridades hacen mucho para ayudar a varias causas que son significativas para ellos. A veces dan de su tiempo, talento o tesoro, mientras que otras veces crean oportunidades para que el resto de nosotros seamos generosos. Posteriormente, la celebridad hace mucho por resaltar la causa, y la esperanza es que suficientes personas den para hacer una diferencia.

Yo nunca juzgo el motivo de otra persona cuando elige dar o apoyar una causa. Sin embargo, escucho muchas veces una crítica impuesta a personas aparentemente ricas que inician una recaudación de fondos y nos piden al resto de nosotros que demos: "Ya que tienen tanto dinero, ¡ellos podrían simplemente dar todo el dinero que se necesita!" Esta exclamación a menudo viene con desdén y un tono de superioridad. Este sentimiento proviene frecuentemente de aquellos que han optado por dar poco o nada a la causa en sí.

La corresponsabilidad comienza con la persona en el espejo. Tú y yo somos responsables el uno con el otro, pero al final del día, el único que sabe el verdadero nivel de nuestra generosidad es Dios. A medida que esta Cuaresma se acerca a su fin, es hora de echar un buen vistazo al espejo. Es probable que tu no seas famoso, por lo que probablemente no habrá una multitud de personas que cuestionen el nivel de tu sacrificio, devoción y generosidad en esta Cuaresma. Por supuesto, Dios lo sabe y también esa persona que te mira en el espejo.

BAPTISMS, PARISH RELIGIOUS EDUCATION,

**Every parishioner should be registered in our parish.** Registration in our parish is a requirement for all individuals seeking sacraments whether it be Baptism, First Holy Communion, Confirmation or Marriage. Only registered parishioners are allowed to celebrate these sacraments and other events like a Quinceañera or Sweet Sixteen Mass. All parishioners need to be registered, using their offertory envelopes, and attending Mass on a regular basis for at least three months before enrolling in our Religious Education Program or seeking any form of religious celebration. Please take a moment to stop by the Parish Office and complete a parish registration information card and schedule yourself to attend our parish Newcomers Orientation & Registration & Meeting! *Weddings, Quinceañeras and Birthday Masses need to be scheduled at least 6 months in advance.*

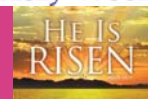

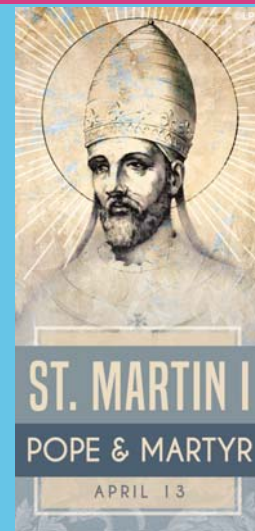
